7) **Supplemental Recruitment Initiatives:**

(a) Initiative: Participation in Job Fairs

Job Fair – March 16, 2017

The Regional Radio Group Operation Manager and Account Executives manned a booth at the annual Adirondack Regional Chamber of Commerce Job Fair held at SUNY Adirondack College from 10:00am to 4:00pm.

Job Fair – October 19, 2017

The Regional Radio Group Account Executives and Morning Show Host of WCQL FM attended the Adirondack Regional Chamber of Commerce / Washington County Job Fair at Rainer's Gourmet Inspiration in Hudson Falls from 4:00pm to 7:00pm.

(b) Initiative: Internship Program

Local High School student (1) and College students (2) participate in an ongoing internship program on site at the Regional Radio Group. Students work in various departments learning about professional equipment, learning how scheduling takes place, observing the writing of copy

and the production of spots, gathering news stories, and learning about the sales department. Most students receive high school or college credit and are evaluated on their participation in the program. Internships range from week-long experiences to approximately 180 hours in length.
